



## GRAIN TESTING FOR NON-PRICING PURPOSES

EFFECTIVE: November 1, 2018

Southwest Grain facilities will run grain tests on samples for non-pricing purposes with the following conditions:

- 1. If for insurance quality testing purposes the producer whose sample is being tested needs to authorize the tests by furnishing a signed form of release by the insurance company.
- 2. If the Southwest Grain Facility asked to run grain tests is busy the request may be denied as to not interrupt or inconvenience patrons.

Southwest Grain personnel may determine that quality tests needed to analyze the sample is outside of our ability and equipment to test and ask that the samples be forwarded to a state or federal inspection agency.
